

PLAR CREDIT REQUEST FORM

After enrolling in courses and paying your fees, you can apply for <u>Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR) credit</u>. If you have previous work, life, or learning experience, including non-credit courses or on the job training, you may be eligible to receive PLAR credit towards your NAIT program.

Note: Student must drop NAIT enrolled course(s) if PLAR Credit is awarded.

- Review our PLAR list to identify if your program has a course(s) formalized to award PLAR credit.
- On your program page, check the PLAR Candidate Guide found under the Advance Credit section to view approved course and requirements.
- There is a \$230 PLAR assessment fee per course; for example, if you believe you are eligible for PLAR for 2 courses, the assessment fee will be \$460. Once you submit a completed request form, monitor your MyNAIT portal and pay the PLAR assessment fee so NAIT can begin the PLAR credit assessment process.
- There may be an additional fee of \$150 if a challenge exam is administered through the NAIT Assessment Centre.
- Complete this PLAR Credit Request form and submit the completed form via email to transfer@nait.ca. Pay the PLAR assessment fee once posted in MyNAIT portal.
