# **Program Details**

### Who's eligible to apply?

- current NAIT students who have completed at least 1 semester of full-time study at NAIT by May 1 of 2020 and are enrolled to study in the Fall 2020 and Winter 2021 semesters.

### What are the requirements and expectations for IPMs?

- commit to the IMP role from August 2020 to May 2021;
- attend an online group interview at the self-selected time in the "Applicant Availability" section;
- attend live online training on August 5 and 6, 2020 (from 9am to 4pm);
- connect, support, and facilitate conversations and activities with your assigned International Peer Groups in each semester (you will learn more details about group activities during the training; all program activities will be online/virtual during pandemic);
- connect peers with the wider NAIT community, resources and other student services;
- host minimum of 4 virtual meetups/activities with each of your International Peer Group (i.e. minimum of 8 meetups/activities from August 2020 to May 2021);
- support and collaborate with other IPMs in organizing virtual group meetups/activities.

### Who should apply?

If you are a current NAIT student who is...

- passionate about creating a supportive and inclusive environment for other students at NAIT, especially those who are new to studying in Canada;
- open to sharing your NAIT stories and experiences with students in the program to support their transition to Canada;
- good at connecting and engaging with other students;
- comfortable hosting virtual meetups and facilitating conversations in a virtual setting;
- eager to polish your student leadership and teamwork skills;
- open and curious to developing your intercultural skills.

### What do I need to include in my application?

- A complete application form (see below);
- A video Cover Letter this will help us to get to know you better (please see detailed instructions in the "Video Cover Letter" section).

- 4. What do you hope to get out of the International Peer Mentor Program?
- 5. Share an experience when you learned something new from a different culture. How did you react to it and what did you learn from this experience?

#### How long is the video?

• The overall time length of your video should not exceed 5 minutes (there's no minimum time requirement).

#### How do I include this video in my application?

Upload your video to a cloud drive (e.g. OneDrive, Google Drive, Dropbox, etc.) or any video website (e.g. YouTube, Vimeo, etc.) where you can generate a safe and link that is *public* or *shared with Freya* (*freyaf@nait.ca*) *directly*. Please *do not* attach the original video file in your application email.
