

## **Alberta Works Funding Attendance and Enrolment Information**

The Alberta Works Foundational Learning Program funding is intended to prepare people for employment. You are expected to be in class 100% of the time, even if you are doing well in your classes. (Please schedule appointments so they do not conflict with class time whenever possible.)

## **POLICY STATEMENT:**

In accordance with Alberta Human Services, Training Provider Regulations Section 5, NAIT must adhere to attendance and enrollment policies for Alberta Works funded learners that meet Alberta Human Services requirements.

## **ATTENDANCE:**

- Attendance will be tracked by your program area
- All absences less than 3 consecutive weeks will be considered unexcused, documentation will not be required
- Full-Time Funding will be terminated if your absences in any class exceed 3 consecutive weeks in a semester, regardless of the reason.
- Part-Time Funding will be terminated if your absences in all classes exceed 3 consecutive weeks in a semester, regardless of the reason.

## **ENROLMENT:**

- Academic Upgrading funded students must be enrolled a minimum of 18 hours of
  instruction per week to be eligible for full-time funding. Less than 18 hours of
  instruction per week is considered part-time.
- **ESL** funded students **must be enrolled in a minimum of 20 hours** of instruction per week to be eligible for **full-time** funding. **Less than 20 hours** of instruction per week is considered **part-time**.
- Reduce Course Load (RCL) approved students are required to be in a minimum 40% course load (based on the hours above) to be considered full-time. (Please note that RCL approval must be authorized by Alberta Human Services)
