



English 30-1 Equivalency Test



TEST INFO:

- The test consists of **five short answer questions** based on a reading, followed by **one 5 paragraph essay**.
- The test follows the outcomes and marking rubrics for **English 30-1** specified on the [Alberta Education website](#).
- The maximum time given is **3 hours** and is completed on the computer in room **L142** on **NAIT's Main Campus**.
- You will be provided with a dictionary, thesaurus, scrap paper, and a handbook entitled *A Canadian Writer's Guide*.
- The cost of the test is **\$300.00**.
- Results will be posted on the MyNAIT Student Portal **ten business days** after the test.
- You may attempt an equivalency test only **ONCE** every 4 months.
- Test results may be used for admissions into NAIT career programs **ONLY**.



KEY POINTS FOR THE TEST:

- You will be required to read a passage (between 3 and 5 pages) prior to answering any of the questions.
- The five short answer questions are entirely based on this passage. Each short answer response should be 1-3 sentences.
- Short answer questions will be graded on your ability to accurately answer the questions using appropriate detail from the passage.
- The 5 paragraph essay is based on this passage.
- The essay will be graded on your ability to respond with a thoughtful, cohesive argument that is well supported by evidence from the passage. You will also be assessed on the accuracy and effectiveness of your writing.
