
1. Visit www.nait.ca



The website will display each group of programs. Click the group that you are searching for.



Entrance Requirements

Academic Requirements

- ▶ Grade 12 English
- ▶ Pure Math 30 or Math 30-1
- ▶ One of: Physics 30, Chemistry 30

Competitive Entrance - 80% overall average (military applicants do not have to be competitive)

Non-Academic Requirements

- ▶ All students must be eligible to complete work experience placements in Alberta Health Services (AHS) facilities. The requirements for these work experience placements are set by AHS and are currently under review. Applicants should be prepared to supply the program with a Criminal Records check including a Vulnerable Sectors check and immunization records consistent with the AHS Immunization policy. For more information, please contact the program office.

6. * Inform your student that in order to know if they meet the exact entrance requirements, they will need to apply to NAIT, pay the foreign document assessment fee and have their transcripts assessed to find their Canadian equivalency.

7. Review the student's transcripts with them to see if they have the classes that are required in
