



Online Interview Information

The interview process consists of two components:

- Part A: School of Health and Life Sciences interview
- Part B: the program-specific interview

The interview scores for both parts are combined for a ranking score. Applicants must complete both parts to be considered for admission.

The interviews are conducted online in the format of pre-recorded videos via a platform called VidCruiter. Applicants should arrange for access to the following to ensure a smooth experience with the interviews:

- A **hard-wired computer** - the varying quality and stability of a wireless network may jeopardize your progress and increase the risk of technical problems.
- Chrome or Firefox as your internet browser. Please avoid Internet Explorer.
- A microphone
- A webcam
- A quiet space where you will not be interrupted for at least 2 hours

Applicants selected to proceed to the Interview phase will receive an email from the School of Health and Life Sciences approximately two weeks before the interview dates. This email contains important information and instructions about the interview process. Please read it carefully and follow the instructions to prepare yourself for the Interview phase.
