



Pre-Arrival Information

As you prepare to travel to Canada during the COVID-19 pandemic, please take special care in your preparation. Immigration, Refugee and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) and the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) have high expectations of travelers entering Canada during the COVID-19 pandemic, which includes you and any accompanying family members flying with you.

The following information applies to you and any family members flying into Canada with you.

Before you travel

- Plan your accommodation and transportation in Canada in advance
 - This includes:
 - 3-day [hotel](#) stay at your city of entry into Canada
 - The remaining 11 days of your quarantine in Edmonton
 - Please review *February 2021 Travel Update* document
 - See *Quarantine Supports for Students Arriving in Edmonton* document
- Download the [ArriveCAN App](#) 48 hours before travelling and register your information
 - Complete the quarantine plan function
- Complete the [Alberta Isolation Questionnaire](#)
- Masks are [mandatory](#) on flights, be sure to have 2-3 on hand for your travel

- Complete NAIT's [Quarantine Questionnaire](#) if you haven't already.



Before you leave home to board your flight, you need the following documents (in hard copy form), in your carry-on baggage:

- Travel Documents:
 - Passport
 - [Temporary Resident Visa \(TRV\)](#), if necessary in your country of citizenship
- Immigration Documents:
 - Study Permit Approval Letter/[Letter of introduction](#)
 - Letter of Acceptance (LOA) from NAIT
 - Proof of [Financial Support](#) for your stay in Canada
- Proof of your studies at NAIT:
 - Confirmation of Enrolment letter, if applicable
 - Unofficial NAIT transcripts, if applicable
- COVID-19 specific information:
 - **Quarantine plan**
 - Including your 3-night stay at a government-approved hotel
 - See *Quarantine Supports for Students Arriving in Edmonton* for more information and complete NAIT's *14-Day Quarantine Questionnaire*
 - **Proof of [your negative COVID-19 test](#)**
 - All travelers 5 years old and over



- Must have been completed at least 72 hours before boarding your flight
 - To find a testing location in your country, please see [here](#).
- If you are travelling with others, they must have the following:
 - A clear quarantine plan
 - Passport
 - Work permit or Visitor permit or Study permit approval letter
 - TRV, if necessary, for their country of citizenship

At the airport in your home country, you will need to be prepared to discuss your travel plans with airline staff and airport officials. Please be aware:

- Airline officials may be conducting health checks.
 - Anyone showing symptoms of COVID-19 will not be able to board their flight to Canada
- Airport officials may ask you about any of the above documents.
 - You should feel comfortable discussing all of those listed above



Upon arrival to Canada

You will be required to:

- Obtain your Study Permit, this will involve speaking with a CBSA Agent
 - They may ask you about any of the above documents and you should feel comfortable discussing all of those listed above.
 - They will give you your Study permit.
 - After receiving your Study permit, you will be permitted into Canada and you will pick up your checked baggage.
 - Keep your Study Permit in a safe, secure location.
 - If you're travelling with others, this is also where they will receive any permits that have been applied for already.
- Take another COVID-19 molecular test
- Stay for up to 3 nights in a [government-authorized hotel](#) as you await the results of your in-Canada COVID-19 test
 - This must be [booked](#) before you leave your home country
 - Must be in the city in which you landed in Canada

After you complete your 3-day stay, you will need to book your flight to Edmonton to complete your remaining 11 days of your quarantine here. To book a flight within Canada, please explore [Air Canada](#) or [WestJet](#) airlines.
