Learning Outcomes	Required Evidence
Learning Outcome 1: Evaluate ethical theories and practices from a variety of perspectives.	Successful completion of the challenge exam with a grade of 70% or higher. The exam consists of three written response questions (500 – 750 words each) with a choice of topics presented for questions two and three. The student is allowed two (2) hours to complete the exam.
Learning Outcome 2: Compose a personal ethical paradigm that integrates social and historical perspectives and current theories/best practices with personal convictions.
