

How to apply to NAIT

International students living in Canada

Requirements

1. Entrance requirements vary by program. Check them for your program of interest on the NAIT program webpage under how to apply at nait.ca/programs.
2. English language proficiency (ELP) for students who do not come from a ELP-exempt country.

NAIT requires Academic English Language Test Scores. For most programs, these are the minimum scores:

- ▶ IELTS 6.5/5.0
- ▶ TOEFL 80/20
- ▶ Pearson 55
- ▶ Duolingo 115
- ▶ Cambridge C1

Required Documents

- ▶ high school transcripts
- ▶ post-secondary school transcripts (if applicable)
- ▶ post-secondary school graduation certificate (if applicable)

How to apply

1. [Apply online](#) for up to two programs. \$115 CAD.
2. Create your [MyNAIT Portal](#) account.
3. Upload required documents on to your MyNAIT Portal.
4. Send original documents to NAIT campus.
5. Login to your MyNAIT Portal for application updates.
6. Accept your offer and pay \$1000 CAD deposit on your MyNAIT Portal.
7. To study at NAIT in a credit program, you'll likely need to [apply for a Canadian Study Permit](#). To study in a non-credit program (e.g. ESL), please review [immigration Canada details](#) and contact an [international advisor](#) for support.
