These are the 14 women killed during the Montreal Massacre on Dec. 6, 1989, during an anti-feminist rampage. This video describes the women slain that day beyond their victimization. A must watch for recognizing the devastation of this horrible event in Canadian history.

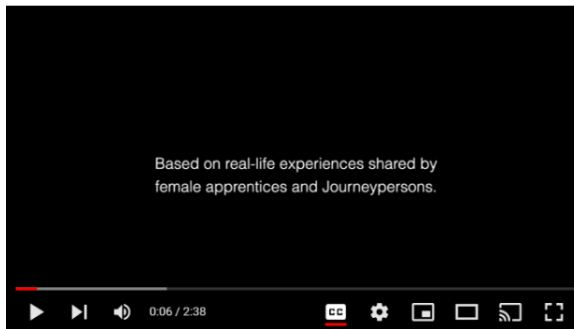
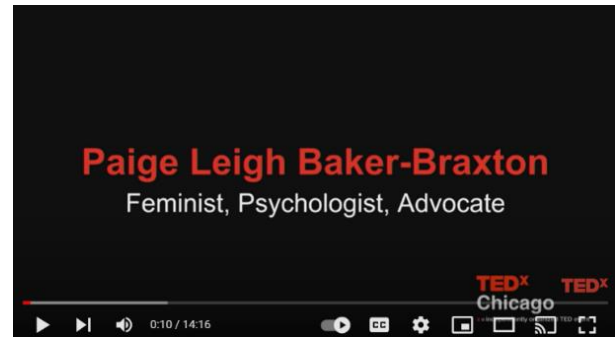


#### 7. Why I'm Done Trying to be Man Enough/Justin Baldoni/TED

### Quick Teaching Exercises

1. Have students free write for 5 minutes on the film contents, asking them to write candidly about their own thoughts and experiences, and how they connect to the film. Assure them there will be no pressure to share their writing.
2. Have students create a 'what if' safety plan for dating/relationships.
3. Have students create a 'what if' safety plan for school or the workplace.

6. Find and deconstruct an ad that is demeaning or displays problematic ideals of masculinity and femininity. In what ways does this ad depict harmful stereotypes?
