



Job Posting – Radio Technician

Description:

Duties and responsibilities of the Radio Technician:

- Two-way radio programming and installation – Build, program, read, modify, and install LMR products in both Digital and Analog systems
 - Using a VSWR and DMM to analyze problems, execute repairs, and verify proper operation
 - Radio and antenna installations at customer sites and into vehicles and heavy equipment in 12- and 24-volt systems
- Installation and termination of coax cabling and other network infrastructure including fiber and copper
- Analyze equipment and system failures and make repairs as required - board level as a minimum
- Industrial, commercial, and residential grade satellite internet installations and support at local or remote site locations
- Infrastructure equipment installations such as antennas, masts and mounts
- Installation and support of wireless point to point and distribution equipment
- Installation and support of camera and security system equipment
- Debit terminal, bank machine, and POS installation and support
- On call support for managed and priority clients with rotating schedule for after hours customer support
- Assist with rental inventory management and equipment upkeep
- Some work will require a physical component including lifting and transporting heavy equipment. Installations are often outdoors throughout the year may require the technician to work at heights or in confined spaces. Physical fitness is a requirement of the position
- Travel for work on in remote locations with limited facilities on a flexible schedule will be expected
- Professional customer interaction skills are a necessity
