

The **Heavy Duty Mechanic** is responsible for the efficient management and supervision in the mechanical repair and maintenance of all of ACE's equipment. From small engines (chainsaws) to pickup trucks, transport trucks and cross country tracked equipment such as Hydro- AX mowers and mulching equipment. The Heavy Duty Mechanic Foreman will have the ability to troubleshoot major and minor mechanical problems, as well as have the aptitude to repair and adjust all necessary mechanical components. Using their experience to prioritize work assignments received in the form of oral or written work orders, the foreman is expected to determine the nature and extent of needed repairs and delegate to other mechanics through effective communication, feedback, and providing ongoing support. Other duties may be assigned as required.

Experience with Hydro Ax Mowers, CMI Mulchers, Nodwells and tracked equipment, tractors and mower decks is mandatory.

Daily duties may include:

- Provide routine maintenance as well as road calls when required.
- Check all heavy equipment for proper performance and inspect equipment to detect faults and malfunctions prior to the equipment being sent to the field.
- Perform related welding on equipment.
- Adhere to workplace safety policies, regulations and compliance's.
- Installation of new and added-on equipment.
- Keep detailed and accurate maintenance reports and documentation.
- Maintain a working knowledge of changes in technology and repair techniques.
- Other mechanical repair work as required.

A Red Seal Journeyman's certificate is a benefit.

- Welding fabrication experience
- 3 years' experience as a Heavy Duty Mechanic supervising other mechanics.
